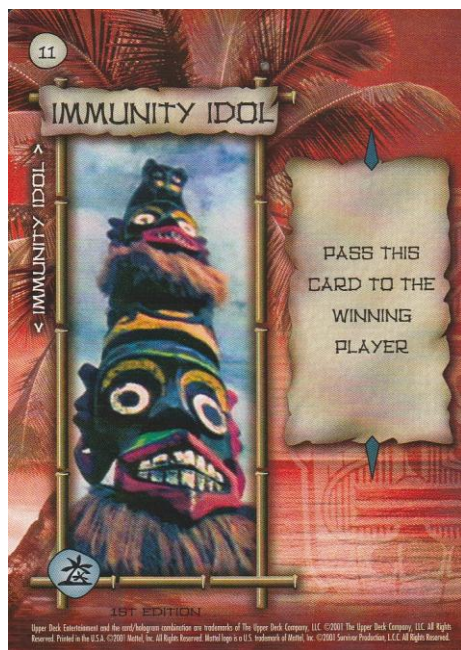

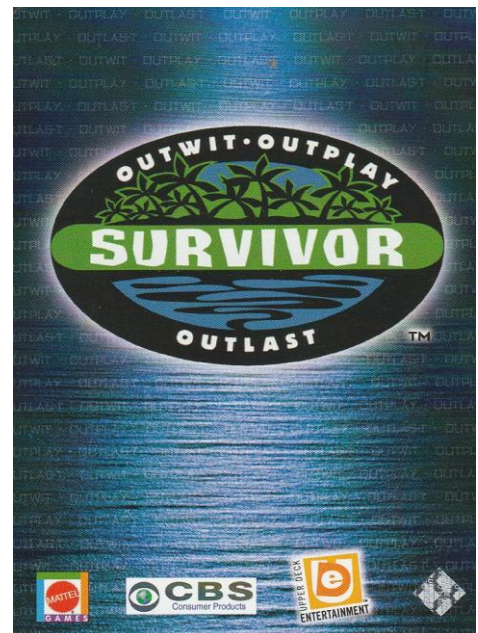

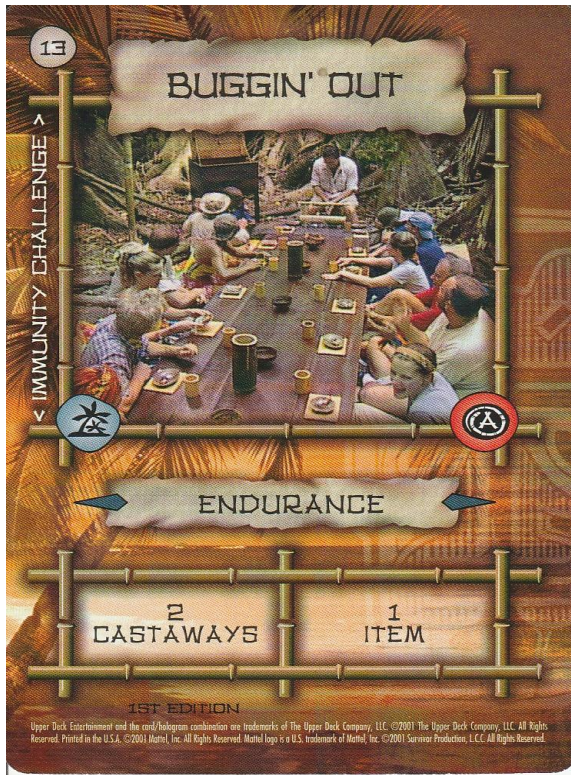
Front of Card



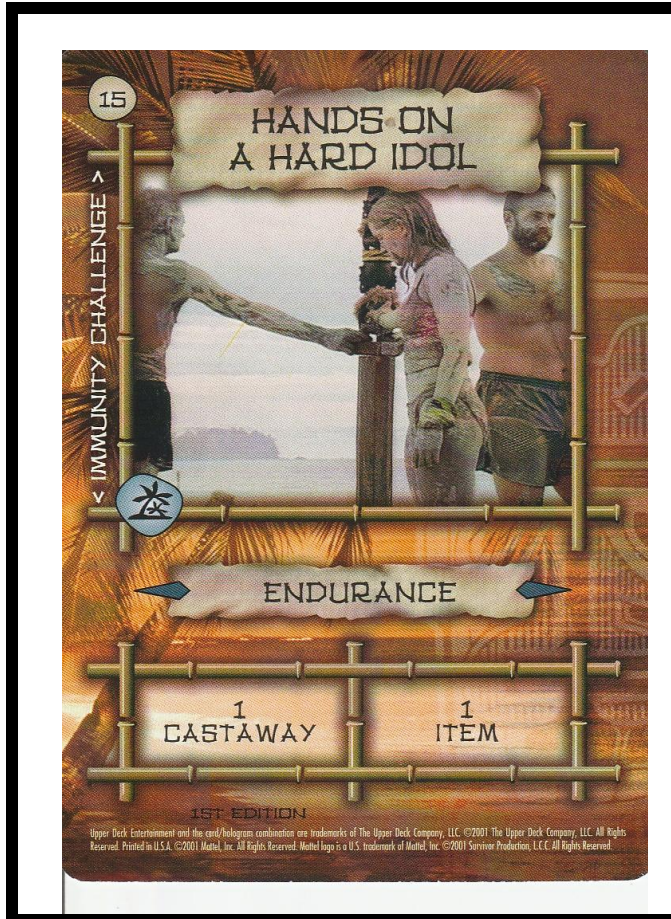
Back of Card

Rules of the Game

This is a portion of the rules included in the evaluation. Full rules, plus sample hands are included in the official evaluation

Here is the breakdown of how to set up and play the game

1. The Setup

To play, you typically need a deck consisting of Survivor cards and "Game" cards (Events, Items, and Advantages).

- **Select Your Survivors:** Each player chooses three Survivor cards to represent their "tribe." Place these face-up in front of you.
- **The Deck:** Randomize a deck from all cards consisting of 40 cards. This is the 'deck'. Shuffle Game cards (Challenges, Alliances, Steal, etc.) and deal five cards to each player.
- **The Life Force:** Each Survivor card has a "Stamina" or "Survival" rating. This is effectively their health.
- **The Draw Pile:** Place the rest of the deck in the center as the draw pile.

2. Card Types

Understanding the cards is key to navigating the "island":

- **Survivors:** Your main characters. If all three are eliminated, you lose.
- **Challenges:** Played against opponents to reduce their Survivors' stamina.
- **Items/Advantages:** Used to buff your own Survivors (e.g., adding stamina or providing immunity).
- **Alliances:** Cards that allow you to group up or protect yourself from specific attacks.

3. How to Play

The game proceeds in rounds, usually following a simple turn structure:

Phase 1: Draw

Draw cards from the main deck until you have **five** in your hand.

Phase 2: Action

On your turn, you can play **two actions**. Actions include:

1. **Playing a Challenge:** Choose one of your Survivors to "challenge" an opponent's Survivor. You compare the stats listed on the cards (often modified by any Item cards you attach).
2. **Using an Item:** Attach a piece of gear to a Survivor to boost their defense or attack power.
3. **Forming an Alliance:** Play an Alliance card to gain a tactical advantage for the next round.

Phase 3: Resolution

If a Survivor loses a challenge and their stamina reaches zero, they are **voted off the island** and discarded.

Sample

- **Jeff Probst:** Before he was the face of the franchise, Probst was almost passed over for the job. He was competing against Phil Keoghan (who went on to host *The Amazing Race*). Probst showed up to his final interview in the same outdoor gear he wore in the pilot, hoping to look the part.
- **Kelly Wiglesworth:** She holds the record for the most consecutive individual immunity wins in the first season (four). After the show, she stepped away from the spotlight for years before returning for *Survivor: Cambodia* 15 years later.
